Tintagel, Cornwall - reconnecting a medieval fortress

Today, Cornwall's Tintagel Castle is divided in two by a rocky, wave-beaten gorge. During the medieval period the two sides were connected by an isthmus. Now, English Heritage is proposing to reconnect the site and recreate the lost land-bridge with a dramatic, cantilevered, steel bridge. The interpretational approach and engineering solution will be outlined.
